

Gardiner Hill Foundation Grant Application

The Gardiner Hill Foundation aims to:

“Enrich and enhance the lives of those with mental health conditions or their carers”

Who can apply?

You may be entitled to a Gardiner Hill Foundation grant if you meet some of the following criteria:

- You are aged 16 or over.
- You are a resident of the geographical boundaries of NAViGO Health & Social Care CIC or have secured accommodation in the borough.
- You are seeking to re-establish yourself, maintain independent living in the community, education or training.
- There is no other way to assist you in re-establishing yourself in the community.
- There is no other option for this funding and this application is of last resort.
- You do not have any other funds saved that you could use to meet your needs.
- You must not have received or be eligible to receive, help from other public funds for the same needs.
- Awards are discretionary and there will be no duty on the Foundation to make an award. Each application will be considered on its own merits.
- The applicant can be the person requiring care, a member of their immediate family, or someone else the applicant or their family will be providing care for.
- The applicant must demonstrate that the award will have a substantial and immediate effect on improving their circumstances.

How we decide what we can assist you with

Upon receipt of your fully completed application, the board of trustees will look at all the information you have provided before deciding if we can make an award. There is limited funding, so we cannot make an award in every case.

Notification of Award

When a decision has been made you will be notified by letter, telephone, email, or via your support worker.

The Foundation may seek repayment of the monetary value of any award from the recipient if it comes to the Foundation’s attention that a grant has been awarded as a result of:

- misleading information
- deception or
- fraud

Furthermore, where it comes to the Foundation’s attention that an award has been used for a purpose other than that for which it was intended, the Foundation may seek repayment of the monetary value of that award.
